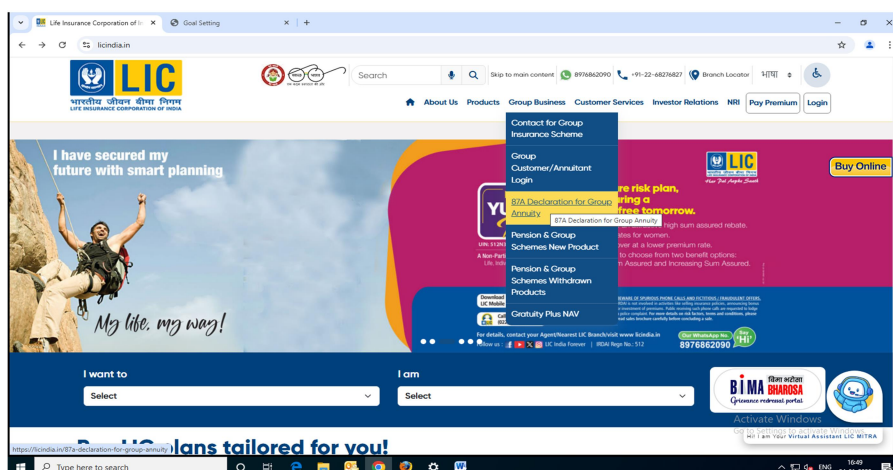


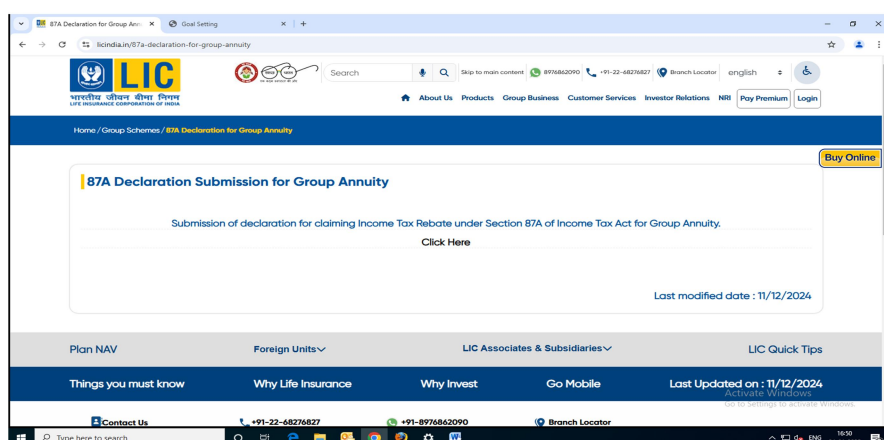
User Guide for accepting 87A declaration by the group Annuitant on LIC Website

Process flow:

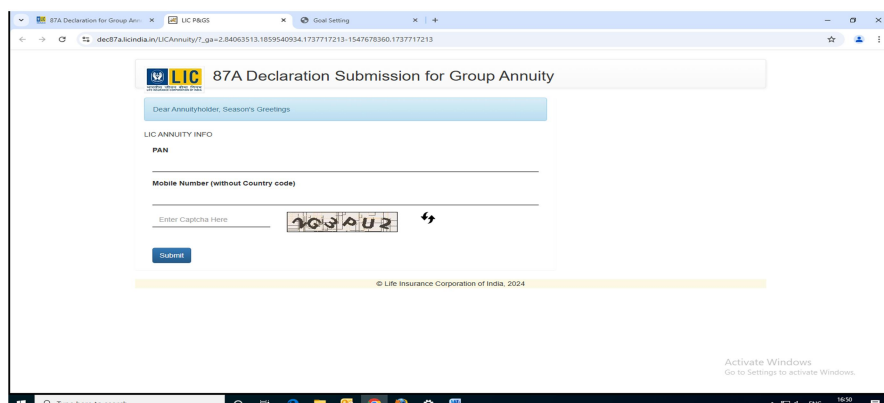
1. Login to LIC web site <https://licindia.in/> and go to option Group Business->87A declaration for group Annuity (see below screen)



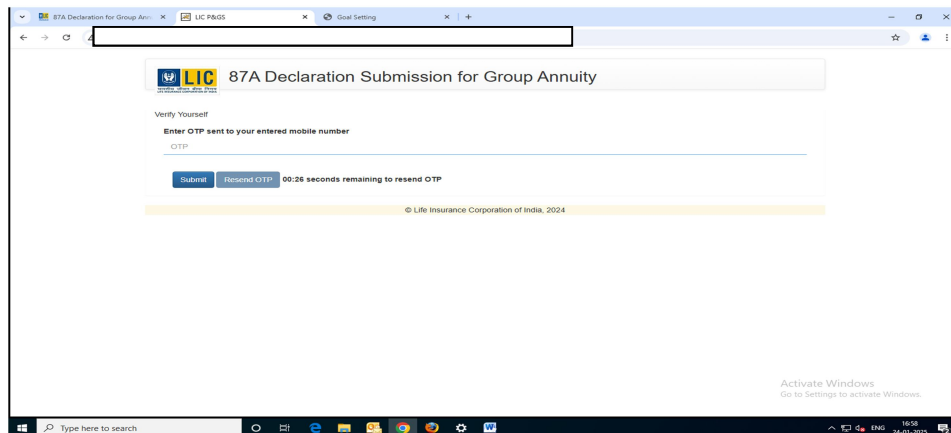
2. Page “87A Declaration Submission for Group Annuity” gets opened. Click on option Click Here (see below screen)



3. The below screen appears

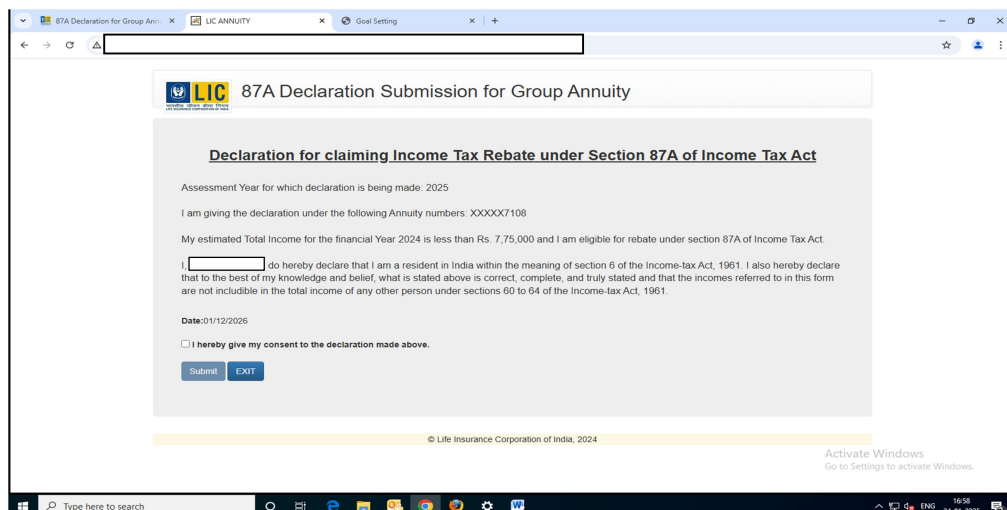


4. Fill the required details and based on PAN & mobile number (if available in LIC record) an OTP will be sent on registered mobile number for mobile number verification. (see below screen)
